Options & pricing

The price you pay is entirely dependent on your choice of options. All burials are single depth including provision for one ash interment at a future date, following the burial. A double depth ash plot is available in all the habitats except the Wildflower Meadow where all ash interments are single depth.

A right of burial is granted for 99 years. There are no additional annual payments

Burial fee

A fee is charged for the safe preparation of the grave for each burial or interment and is in addition to the plot price.

Cedar Hall

The award winning Cedar Hall is available to hire for an hourly fee for a funeral or memorial service.

This includes a single photo shown throughout the service, music and a music tribute (valued at £77 with up to 25 photos timed to your chosen music) all supported by Obitus.

A choice of alternative tributes are available if required in addition to keepsakes. Please ask the team for information and pricing.

Cremation service

Arrangements can be made with your funeral director for a weekday service in the Cedar Hall, either in the morning or afternoon, followed by an unattended cremation at a nearby crematorium.

Memorials

A bronze plaque mounted on an oak post is available as a memorial for a burial or ash interment within the Bluebell Wood and Diamond Jubilee Wood.

York stone memorials are available in the Oak Meadow, Woodland Meadow and the Wildflower Meadow.

To maintain the aesthetics of the park, we request that all memorials and trees (Wildflower Meadow only) are purchased through Norfolk Bluebell Wood Ltd.

A bronze plaque mounted on an oak post can be purchased in various shapes including star, circle, rectangle, pillow, oval and heart.

Our local woodcarver can carve an additional memorial at the top of the plaque, with a maximum height of 150 mm. The cost will vary depending on the carving.

Sponsor a bird or bat box

A bird or bat box can be placed in an approved position for a period of ten years.

Bronze plaque on wooden bench or oak obelisk

Wooden benches have been placed throughout the habitats in the park to provide a resting place for quiet reflection. A bronze plaque can be placed on one of these benches or on an oak obelisk in the Robert Marsham Glade for a period of ten years.

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Wooden vase

A single wooden vase is available to purchase for displaying flowers on an ash interment plot and two vases are permitted on a burial plot.

A biodegradable acorn shaped urn is available to purchase for an ash interment.

The price you pay is entirely dependent on your choice of options including habitat within the park. Prices are reviewed annually on 31 March.

A percentage of all burial plot purchases are reserved for the long-term maintenance of the park.
